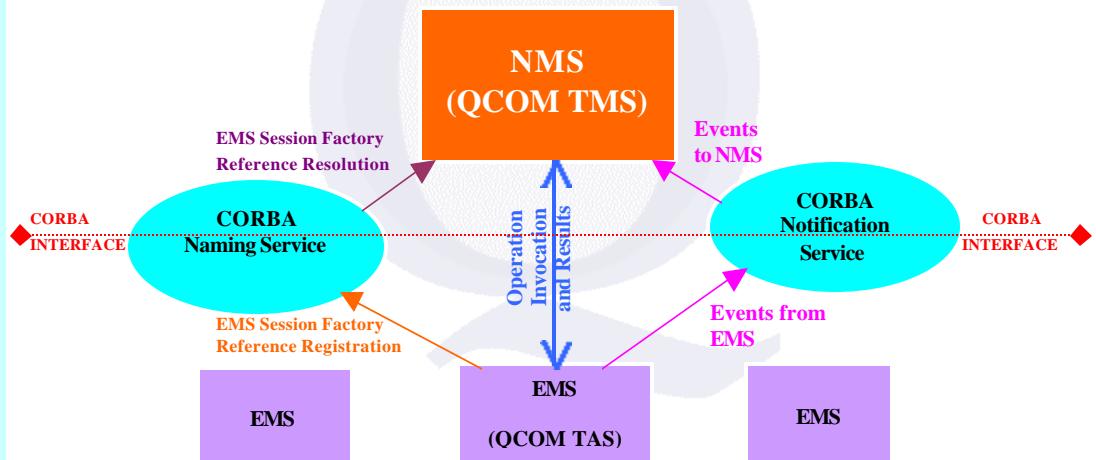

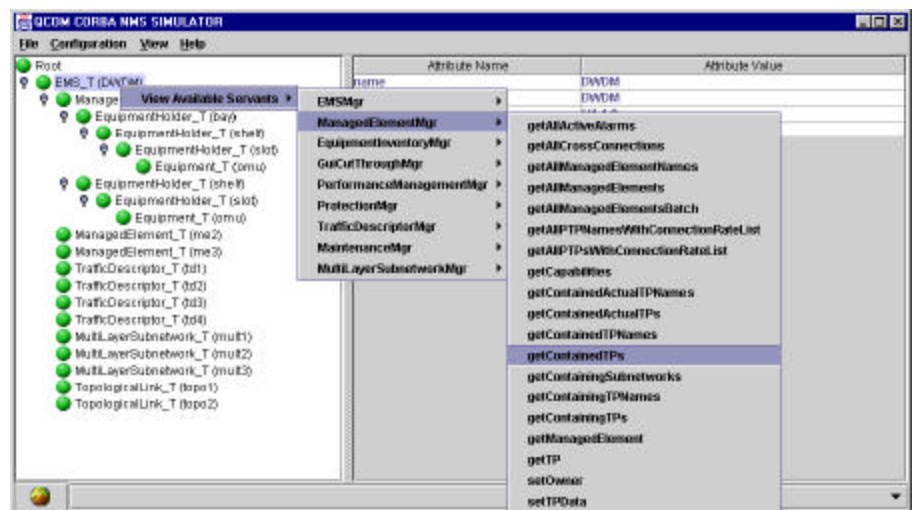

Batch Testing through Tcl Script

Along with the user-friendliness of the Graphical Interface, QCOM TMS provides the power of batch testing through its Tcl Scripting Mode. Test cases can be formulated and written in the form of Tcl Scripts, which can then be executed without any further user intervention.

Handles Proprietary IDL Extensions

QCOM understands that the standard TMF IDL set may not be sufficient to support all the functions for the EMS – NMS interface desired by your company. In anticipation of this need, QCOM has built into its TMS the capability to incorporate proprietary IDL extensions. Users can run tests based on the additional interfaces and methods provided in the new IDL set.

Built in Naming Service Browser

QCOM TMS has a built in Naming Service Browser, which allows users to browse any OMG compliant Naming Service and connect to the EMS of their choice. At the same time, it also provides the flexibility of reading the EMS CORBA reference (IOR) from a file.

Receives Alarms and Events

As recommended by TMF, QCOM TMS uses CORBA Notification Services to receive Alarms and Events sent by EMS. You can select your own filter based on the various Event Types defined by TMF to filter out any particular types of Events that you do not wish to receive.

Full Feature Configurable Log for both Operations and Events

TMS has built-in detailed logging capability. It logs all operations invoked including their results received, as well as complete details of the Events received. All log entries have individual time stamps. Each day new log files are automatically created for both Operation and Event log, with current date appended to the respective file names. The log is configurable in terms of the amount of detailing you want and can also be set to wrap over on reaching a certain size.

Supports Multiple EMSs

One instance of QCOM TMS can connect to and test multiple EMSs at the same time.
